

COMMUNITY RECREATION AND SPORT FACILITIES PROGRAM

PURPOSE

The Community Recreation and Sport Facilities Program (CRSFP) offers financial assistance for the planning and development of sustainable, inclusive, functional and fit for purpose sport and active recreation facilities that meet the current and future needs of the South Australian community.

HIGHLIGHTS

Budget

\$7.195 Million for 2012-13

Who's Eligible

- Not-for-profit, incorporated sport and active recreation groups that do not hold a Gaming Machine Licence
- Not-for-profit, incorporated community based organisations, whose role is to manage active recreation and sport facilities (e.g. Progress Associations), that do not hold a Gaming Machine Licence
- Local Councils
- Education Institutions
- Applications from non-sport or recreation organisations must demonstrate how the project will address access and capacity issues for community sport and active recreation.

What and how much can you apply for?

There will be 4 grant types:

Category 1 – Facility Planning Projects

Category 2 – Facility Development Projects (funding up to \$200,000)

Category 3 – Facility Development Projects (funding from \$200,001 up to \$500,000)

Category 4 – Community Sports Hub and Major Projects (funding up to \$2.5 million)

Please note that:

- Applicants will be eligible to apply for one project per category
- Applicants for Category 2 and 3 must demonstrate at least a matched funding commitment
- Applicants for Category 3 and 4 will make application through an Expression of Interest (EOI) process
- Applicants must demonstrate landowner consent for the project. A template will be provided to assist applicants.
- Affiliated sport or active recreation organisations should seek the endorsement of the relevant state association or peak body. A template will be provided to assist applicants.
- Facility projects that are unsuccessful under the Active Club Program electoral allocation will get a second chance assessment under category 2 of the Community Recreation and Sport Facilities Program.

When can you apply ?

The following dates are anticipated for the next round:

2012-13 – opens 3 March 2012 and closes 30 April 2012.

Application Process

Successful applicants will be notified and required to enter into a formal agreement with the Minister for Recreation and Sport

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
