

SPORT AND RECREATION SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM

PURPOSE

The Sport and Recreation Sustainability Program (SRSP) assists State Sport and Active Recreation Organisations and Industry Representative Bodies to provide leadership for sport and active recreation in South Australia. Organisations should provide vision and direction for their sport or activity and support members and affiliates.

HIGHLIGHTS

Budget

\$3.1 Million per annum

Who's Eligible

State Sport and Active Recreation Organisations and Industry Representative Bodies with an annual turnover of less than \$10 million per annum.

What can you apply for?

The financial assistance is to provide leadership for sport or active recreation across South Australia.

How much can you receive funding for?

The maximum amount that an applicant can be allocated under the SRSP is \$100,000 per annum. Organisations will be assessed on the basis of the profiling information provided.

Please note:

- The SRSP will be notionally allocated for up to three years on a triennial basis.
- For recognised State Sport Organisations for people with disabilities the assessment will recognise the additional costs in providing sport and active recreation opportunities for people with a disability.
- The assessment will recognise the additional costs to organisations providing elite sporting pathways that are aligned with a recognised SASI program.

When can you apply?

The following dates are anticipated for the next round:
2012-15 Notional Allocations – opens 4 February 2012 and closes 26 March 2012.

Application Process

Guidelines and Application Forms will be available when the rounds open.

Organisations wishing to apply for SRSP will be required to enter profile information via a secure on-line portal.

Successful organisations will be notified and required to enter into a formal agreement with the Minister for Recreation and Sport
